## Dual Enrollment Policy

Policy No. 7

---

Freedom Academy may accept students enrolling only for full or  $\frac{3}{4}$  time (approx. 4.8 hrs. per school day). Students enter the school through the annual lottery system and due to the large wait lists at every grade level, we feel that open seats should be occupied by students who are seeking full time status.

Exceptions will be made on an individual basis. See points below for further information.

1. If a student is attending at least  $\frac{3}{4}$  time, Freedom Academy may document release time to parents without the student needing to return to their local school district to complete the formal process for home school status. Documentation of the parent's request and rationale for the release time is required for review by the administration. . Charter schools do not grant home school status per Utah Code 53A-11-102(2)(a).
2. If the student is a SPED student then the IEP team should meet and determine an appropriate IEP that provides FAPE in the LRE.
3. If a student seeks less than  $\frac{3}{4}$  time, Freedom Academy will refuse to accept the student.
4. A student who is dually enrolled is only expected to take CRT's and other assessments for which they receive instruction. If the student takes math at the charter school, but not science, then the student would take the CRT math exam but not science.
