Student Debts and Obligations Textbook Policy

Policy No. 13

Freedom Academy may impose the following sanctions against students for:

- non-payment of fees including tuition for clubs, classes and sports
- missing library books
- lost, stolen or damaged text books
- lost or damaged calculators
- sports equipment
- other school materials, (art, music, science, computers, CTE)
- vandalized personal or school property
- attendance violations

These sanctions may include but are not limited to:

1. Withhold current report card
2. Denial of participations in eight grade graduation ceremony
3. Denial of right to obtain yearbook
4. Denial of participation in extracurricular activities
5. Bill for the cost of the repair or replacement of damaged or lost items
6. Suspension from Freedom Academy
7. Police report/investigation

The school may impose other sanctions which do not interfere with a resident student's right to attend a public school.
