TITLE I BASICS

- The Title I Program provides schools with a higher level of poverty with additional funding to support students in their academic goals.
- Freedom Preparatory Academy: Provo Elementary and Secondary Campus are school wide Title I schools.
- This means that at least 40% of our students are eligible for free or reduced lunch.
- As a schoolwide Title I program, Freedom Preparatory uses our Title I funds to ensure ALL students meet or exceed their grade level academic standards by the end of the year.
- The use of all funds are monitored yearly to ensure compliance.

TITLE I FUNDS


- Freedom Preparatory Academy received \$191,547.86 in Title I funds for the 2020-2021 school year.
- These funds are evenly split between our elementary and secondary campuses.

- Literacy Goals
 - By May 2021, first grade teachers and paraprofessionals will increase the percentage of first grade students at or above benchmark on Acadience Reading nonsense word fluency- whole word read (NWF-WWR) by 3% from BOY to EOY by providing daily whole class and small group direct instruction in blending strategies to increase students' ability to blend (silently) CVC words and increase the number of students who reach benchmark in NWF-WWR by the end of 1st grade.
 - By May 2021, second grade teachers and paraprofessionals will maintain the percentage of second grade students at or above benchmark on Acadience Reading sub-measure of Oral Reading Fluency from BOY to EOY by teaching students sight words through direct instruction, flash cards, and repeated readings to increase students' ability to read frequently seen grade level words which will increase students' wpm rate (fluency) and accuracy rate on irregular read words.
- 5 Title I Paraprofessionals that assist students in reading (1st -5th grade).
