Class Registration Process for Semester 1:

After completing the FPVA registration form, students will be enrolled in Edgenuity, our online learning platform. Students will then self-enroll in Semester 1 classes in Edgenuity by doing the following:

1. You will receive your Edgenuity username and password in an email. If you do not receive an email, contact FPVA Secretary at 385-248-5500 to receive your Edgenuity username and password.
2. Go to <https://auth.edgenuity.com/Login/Login/Student> and login in with your given username and password.
3. In the top right corner of the screen, click the + icon.
4. From the list of "Other Courses," find your required classes (listed above), and click "Enroll" for each one.
5. From the list of "Other Courses," choose the appropriate number of electives for your grade level (listed above) for the current semester and click "Enroll" for each course.

For example: If I am a 9th grader, and I need to take 2.5 credits of electives for the year, I will select two elective classes if it is 1st semester, or I will select three electives if it is 2nd semester.

Note: Be sure to only choose classes for which you have already taken the pre-requisite.

6. Your class choices will be reviewed by a school counselor, and you will be contacted if there are any questions or concerns regarding your schedule.

You will register for Semester 2 courses at a later date.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

One half credit (.5) is earned for each course passed each semester. The class of 2021 and future classes will all need to earn 28 total credits to graduate. Elective credits will come from the elective category or a fourth credit of Math, Science, or additional years of Fine Arts, PE, CTE, etc.
