Class Registration Process for Semester 1:

After completing the FPVA registration form, students will be enrolled in Edgenuity, our online learning platform. Students will then self-enroll in Semester 1 classes in Edgenuity by doing the following:

- 1. You will receive your Edgenuity username and password in an email. If you do not receive an email, contact FPVA Secretary at 385-248-5500 to receive your Edgenuity username and password.
- 2. Go to https://auth.edgenuity.com/Login/Login/Student and login in with your given username and password.
- 3. In the top right corner of the screen, click the + icon.
- 4. From the list of "Other Courses," find your required classes (listed above), and click "Enroll" for each one.
- 5. From the list of "Other Courses," choose the appropriate number of electives for your grade level (listed above) for the current semester and click "Enroll" for each course.

For example: If I am a 9^{th} grader, and I need to take 2.5 credits of electives for the year, I will select two elective classes if it is 1^{st} semester, or I will select three electives if it is 2^{nd} semester.

Note: Be sure to only choose classes for which you have already taken the pre-requisite.

6. Your class choices will be reviewed by a school counselor, and you will be contacted if there are any questions or concerns regarding your schedule.

You will register for Semester 2 courses at a later date.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

One half credit (.5) is earned for each course passed each semester. The class of 2021 and future classes will all need to earn 28 total credits to graduate. Elective credits will come from the elective category or a fourth credit of Math, Science, or additional years of Fine Arts, PE, CTE, etc.

University admissions standards and scholarship programs may have differing requirements, it is your responsibility to research and meet those requirements.

4 credits (one course per year) Language Arts

3 credits Math (to include Sec. Math I, II, III or approved course)

3 credits Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics or approved course)

3 credits Social Studies (Geography .5, World History or

AP World History 1.0, US History or AP US History 1.0, Government .5)

2 credits Foreign Language (two consecutive years of same language)

1.5 credits Fine Arts

1.0 credit CTE courses

0.5 credit Computer Science or any Introductory Level Computer Class

0.5 credit College & Career Readiness

0.5 credit Health

0.5 credit Financial Literacy

1.5 credits Physical Education
