An elementary school or teacher may compile and provide to a student's parent a suggested list of supplies for use during the regular school day so that a parent may furnish, on a voluntary basis, those supplies for student use. Otherwise, they will be furnished by the school.</p>	<p>All donations are strictly voluntary and are in no way required for participation in any elementary school activity. Below are donation opportunities a family may wish to contribute to:</p> <p>Various Field trips: the donation will be used to help assist with the cost of various field trips through the school year. Fee Waivers: Parents must fill out a fee waiver application form provided by the Utah State Board of Education annually. Fee waiver applications are available in Freedom Prep's front office and Freedom Prep's website: www.freedomprep.net. Required verification of eligibility details can be found in the fee waiver application form. It is necessary that each family be approved **annually**. Last year's application will not be valid. Fee waiver application candidates will receive notification from the Finance Office of approval or denial. If applicants are denied, fees are due. See Freedom Prep Academy's School Fees and Fee Waivers Policy for appeal process.

Lunch Fees: School breakfast and lunch are offered at Freedom Preparatory Academy every school day. These costs are separate from school fees. Please see the school website for current prices and menu (www.freedomprep.net). To view the menu, click on onsite schools, Provo K-5, overview. For Free/Reduced lunch application go to the school website, and click on Info, then Child Nutrition-LINQ and scroll down to Lunch Account Management for instructions on how to apply for Free/Reduced benefits. A new application MUST be submitted each year. To ensure approval on the first day of school, applications must be submitted at least 10 days prior to the first day of school. Students who purchase lunch prior to receiving acceptance will be responsible for lunch fees. The state does not allow retroactive payment for late applications.

The maximum total aggregate fee amount per student per school year is \$1,000
